1. It is the CTA's view that, for driving licence purposes, a person cannot be considered to be unpaid when driving for an organisation and be a current employee for that same organisation
2. MAM is Maximum Authorised Mass of the vehicle (also known as the GVW – Gross Vehicle Weight).
3. Drivers who had a D1 (101) can reapply for this category to be put back on their driving licence after the age of 70, provided they have passed a PCV medical. Drivers who never had the D1 (101) licence category entitlement, and have subsequently reached the age of 70, will need to pass a PCV medical to obtain the B (120) licence entitlement to allow them to continue to drive a minibus as a volunteer.
